

# Tidenham Parish Council

## Community Facilities Policy

Tidenham Parish Council is committed to ensuring the continued provision and development of Community and Recreational facilities throughout the Parish of Tidenham subject to the availability of funds.

The Parish Council will therefore work in partnership with a number of organisations including charitable trusts to provide such facilities as deemed necessary by the Parish Council to meet the needs of the Parish and the above commitment.

The Parish Council will continue to provide a community building and recreational facilities in Sedbury and work in conjunction with Sedbury and Beachley Village Hall Charity, Two Rivers Housing and others to provide such facilities.

The Parish Council will continue to support those aims common to both Tidenham War Memorial Hall & Recreation Ground Trust and Tidenham Parish Council in the provision of a community building and recreational facilities in Tutshill.

The Parish Council will continue to support the provision of a play area in Woodcroft.

The Parish Council will consider requests from local communities and community groups for support to provide facilities throughout the parish.


### Notes:

A range of community buildings and recreational facilities are provided by the MOD in Beachley. The buildings are not generally made available by the MOD to other users.

A community building is provided at Tidenham Chase by the trustees of the Old School at Rosemary Lane.

Local Churches, Schools and other organisations also allow some community use of their own facilities.
