



**EMERGENCY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH FTM19, TINTERN QUARRY,  
PARISH OF TIDENHAM, FOREST OF DEAN**

Gloucestershire County Council has by this emergency notice closed temporarily under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) part of Public Footpath FTM19 (Tintern Quarry) from its junction with FTM20 at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference OSG ST 5434/9789 and then extends in a generally easterly direction for approximately 630 metres to its junction with FTM104 (Offas Dyke Path) at OSG ST 5488/9780 and shown on the Map by a bold solid black line marked A to B.

The public footpath falls within the Parish of Tidenham in the District of The Forest Of Dean Gloucestershire.

The closure is necessary due to blockage of the route and the route running to an unsafe point at the quarry face.

This Notice came into force on the 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2018 and will continue for up to 21 days. However, if the works to remedy the problem have not been completed during this time scale it will be necessary to either extend the closure by Notice for a further 21 days, or make an Order.

This legal Order will authorise the closure of the public footpath for up to six months from the date of this Notice. However, if the problem continues after this time then it will be necessary to make an application to the Secretary of State for an extension to the closure.

The alternative route is from Point A via footpaths FTM20 and FTM104 to Point B.

Emergency and Pedestrian access is to be maintained.
