- a. **P0760/23/FUL** Honeysuckle Cottage, Miss Grace Lane, Tidenham Chase, Chepstow. Erection of single storey side extension to South East elevation with associated works. **Tidenham Parish Council supports this application.**
- b. P0999/23/FUL 7 Gloucester Road, Tutshill, Chepstow, NP16 7DB. Erection of a single storey rear extension with associated works. Tidenham Parish Council supports this application.
- c. P0871/23/TPO St Johns On The Hill School, Castleford Hill, Tutshill, Chepstow.
  Crown Reduction Works to 1 x Sycamore (Acer pseudoplatanus), covered by G1 of DFTPO 218 (referred to as T67 in accompanying tree survey). Specification to include a spread reduction by the removal of 1 x scaffold stem and 2 x secondary branches, as indicated in red on image, cutting back to strong secondary growth. Additional works include light pruning of the extended tips of no more than 1 meter on the road side only.

- **c. Resolved to note** eleven people attended the Community Speedwatch training on Thursday, 3<sup>rd</sup> August, 2023. Speedwatch sessions on Beachley Road, Beachley have been arranged. The Assistant Clerk to investigate using a polling application, such as Doodle Poll, to arrange future Community Speedwatch sessions.

## 13. TO RECEIVE COUNCILLORS' LOCAL REPORTS AND MATTERS FOR THE NEXT AGENDA

**Cllr. Koning** – advised that the quality of road repairs on the junction of Stoulgrove Lane and Woodcroft Lane, the repainting of the no parking road markings on Woodcroft Lane and the repositioning of the grit bin that is blocking the pavement on the junction of Woodcroft Lane and B4228 have still not been addressed. The Assistant Clerk to write to GCC Highways for an update.

**Clir. Russell** – expressed concern that there are various extensions, conversions, etc being built and that it is unclear whether or not these have been through the planning process, and enquired about the rules for permitted development verses a planning application. The Assistant Clerk advised there is guidance information on the FoDDC Planning website.
